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New Examination pattern from 2017-18 onwards.

1. CBSE has restored the class X board examination with effect from academic year 2017-18. Details of the new examination scheme is available in circular number Acad-05/2017 dated 31-01-2017
2. Students of class X can opt for additional subjects(not compulsory) as per the annexure –I of the above circular
3. All the three periodic tests for classes IX and X will be of cumulative nature.
4. For classes VI to VIII, there will be two terms. However the yearly exam in the month of March will include syllabus from term 1. (10% in class VI, 20% in class VII and 30% in class VIII). For uniformity, the syllabus of Term 1 for including in term 2 examinations will be decided by KVS and intimated soon.

5. Classes III to V there will be two terms separately. Classes I and II will have eight cycles of tests as earlier.
6. Periodical test- 1 for classes III to XI should be held on 1st Week of August covering the syllabus completed up to 31st July as per the new split up syllabus circulated. The question paper setting and evaluation will be at vidyalaya level. Maximum marks for all the above tests is 50 and time duration is 90 minutes

7. Term 1 examination for classes III to VIII, Periodic Test-2 for classes IX and X (Mid Term Test) and half yearly Exam for class XI will be held in the first week of October covering the syllabus up to 30th September. Question paper for classes III to V will be prepared at vidyalaya level. The question paper for classes VI to XI will be prepared at Regional level. The evaluation for all the above classes will be at vidyalaya level
8. Periodical test-2 for classes III to VIII & XI, Periodical test -3 for IX to X will be held in the first week of January. The syllabus for classes IX and X will be cumulative.
9. There is 5% weightage for note book submission in classes III to X. All teachers should be instructed to maintain a record of assessment of note book on a monthly basis (maximum 10 marks). The total of term in classes III to VIII and full year for classes IX and X can be reduced to 5 for calculation of marks. The note books are to be evaluated for regularity in submission, completion of assignments/HW and neatness and upkeep of the note book. Note books of Class X students are to be preserved (all volumes) as evidence of assessment for CBSE.
